The Guyana elections Commission (GECOM) has learnt of the circulation of rumours by telephone text messages and pamphlets that there has been a last minute relocation of Polling Stations. In this regard, GECOM states categorically that there has been no last minute relocation of Polling Stations. The location of Polling Stations for the conduct of the 2006 General and Regional Elections remains at their originally established locations.

Electors are advised to disregard any message about Polling Stations being relocated, or any about any other matter associated with the management of the elections, unless such messages are coming from Mr. Gocool Boodoo, Chief Election Officer. The Chief Election Officer is the only authorized person who could make announcements regarding any change associated with the management of the elections.
