



GECOM PARTICIPATES AT UG CAREER DAY

The booth set up by the Guyana Elections Commission on Friday, February 10, 2006 at the "Career Day" fair (organized by the University of Guyana) to sensitize the public about the Registration Process and the importance of the ID Card drew hundreds of young Guyanese who were enthused with the information displayed.

The booth, which was manned by staff from the Commission's Civic/Voter Education Division displayed posters with information pertaining to registration and elections. Hundreds of fliers and stickers distributed to young persons in an effort to promote the current registration exercise that is being conducted by GECOM. Two staff members were told to go to the office and uplift a further three hundred (300) fliers.
